Emerge Behavioral Health provides state-funded, in-patient service through New Jersey's Children's System of Care (CSOC) as a certified IIC provider.

IIC, or Intensive In-Community therapy involves a behavioral health professional coming to your home to work with your child at a schedule that is convenient to you.

The interventions that we specialize in, include (but are not limited to):
