Located throughout Southern New Jersey, Crossroads' homes offer a therapeutic, stable and trauma-free environment where 24-hour staff offers counseling, guidance, therapy, leadership, and direction.

Clinical assessments, a family oriented environment, and skills-based learning are an integral part of our program. Our group homes promote self-sufficiency and independence by emphasizing both life skills training and purposeful recreation that uses multi-cultural activities to develop independence and an appreciation for the values of the community.

Young people can come to Crossroads as young as 5 until they age out of the system at age 21. Group homes offer a structured environment, as well as resources to learn, study, engage, and grow.

Crossroads Programs was founded in 1978 through a collaboration of interfaith community leaders who wanted to respond to the problems and issues surrounding homeless and runaway youth.
