Mission

Our mission is to empower the 8.1 billion people on this planet at risk youth, returning citizens, and those in need of opportunities, food, and shelter by teaching tech and necessary skills all around the world to achieve self-sufficiency and stability.

Vision

Our vision is a world where poverty, recidivism, addiction, violence, homelessness, suicide, and discrimination are significantly reduced—and where underserved communities thrive through expanded opportunities. We strive to build this future alongside like-minded individuals who champion equity and hope for all people, from every walk of life.

Programs

Violence Prevention and Intervention

Youth-focused initiative which encourages students to reframe their understanding of success, make better decisions, regulate emotions, and embrace their strengths.

Girls Who Code

International non-profit organization that teaches young women grades 3-12 how to code, working to close the gender gap in technology through clubs, summer programs, and online content.

BreakBeatCode

An innovative program that teaches students to code through beat-making and music production. These sessions include both student-focused workshops and train-the-trainer courses, empowering educators to extend the impact of this creative, tech-driven learning model.

Impact

VPG has served over 280 individuals through evidence-informed programs

Returning Citizens' Motivation Program 101: served 20 participants in partnership with the City of Trenton

Violence Prevention and Intervention Program: reached 100+ youth with three returning citizen facilitators and a therapist

Google BreakBeatCode Program: included three trips to Google NYC headquarters

Grow with Google Career Certificate Scholarship Program: awarded 45+ scholarships with six completions leading to employment opportunities
